



Irv Lebowitz, 79, of Kingston, died Thursday morning, January 23, 2020, in the Jewish Home of Eastern Pennsylvania, Scranton.

Born in Wilkes-Barre, he was the son of the late Sidney and Helen Lebowitz and was a graduate of Wilkes College, where he earned his Masters degree in Elementary Education and attended Brooklyn College.
